## Programme

### What QUEEN TROPHY is

The Queen Trophy is an Adventouring event where fun riding is combined with breath-taking sceneries, and the discovery of the most hidden treasure troves of the central Apennines.

Even this year, to meet the needs of all our riders, we propose **three different itineraries** aimed at entertaining those who are approaching the off-road riding (**STANDARD**), those who are used to off-road riding (**ADVANCE**), and those who wish for harder testing and possess an advanced riding technique (**EXPERT**).

### Our Itineraries

**STANDARD itineraries** are a combination of beautiful, smooth roads and paths, though with a pinch of zest! They require a minimum of off-road riding experience and a few training laps on dirt roads, but nothing more. A fairly easy route, especially if driving a heavy bike, though never boring.

In short, standard is standard, not soft so do not be fooled into thinking it might be unexciting!

The **ADVANCE** and **EXPERT** itineraries are suitable for those riders who are familiar with off-road riding on rough surfaces, hence riders who frequently ride off-road (ADVANCE) and riders possessing a mature and enduro riding technique (EXPERT).

Our itineraries have been described as challenging. **NOT** so! Simply chose the itinerary that best suits your abilities without overestimating yourself.

### Allowed Motorbikes

In compliance with the FMI Regulations, only off-roads bikes weighing 150 kgs or more may participate to the event.

EXCEPTIONS MADE FOR BIKES WEIGHING LESS THAN 150 KGS:

- Women irrespectively of their motobike,
- Riders driving KTM 690 HUSQVARNA 701 GASGAS 700, HONDA CRF300L CRF 300RALLY motorbikes,  
and 30 year old motorbikes— or younger if entered into the historic register - bikes.

### Tires

ONLY knobby tires are allowed. Tires will be inspected before administrative checks.

“We recommend Metzeler Karoo 4 and Karoo Extreme”.

### Safety and Control

- In order to increase safety and improve services at the 2023 event, a detection system – shall be installed on the motorbikes of participants. **(The installation of the transponder is mandatory, departure may not be allowed without)**. The system will allow us to follow each and every rider live from our control station throughout the entire itenary.
- This tools detects the ridden route and bike speed so to guarantee personal safety and a prompt intervention in case of need, as well as checking that the limitations imposed by the Authorities are respected. Non-compliant bikers may even be disqualified.

### Disqualification cases

It is expressly forbidden to cross meadows, bikers must remain on the marked road.

It is expressly forbidden to exceed the imposed speed limits as indicated on the track.  
It is expressly forbidden to transit at speeds exceeding 40 km/hour in built-up areas, near houses, near people cycling or walking or near animals.

- A2 TWO DAYS** (Saturday and Sunday): the subscription fee includes a guide for two days, medical assistance, light mechanical assistance, tracking system, gadgets, Saturday snack and dinner, Sunday breakfast, snack, lunch and luggage transport.  
**Checks and inspections** upon Friday leg arrival, from 17:00 to 19:00 **300 €**  
**Friday 8/9/2023 dinner** is to be booked in advance. Cost is 33.00 €
- A3 THREE DAYS** (Friday, Saturday and Sunday) the subscription fee includes a guide for three days, medical assistance, light mechanical assistance, tracking system, gadgets, Friday snack at departure, light lunch, and dinner, Saturday light lunch and dinner, Sunday lunch and luggage transport. **420 €**
