QUEEN TROPHY 2021 REGULATIONS

Art. 1

Motoclub Pepe BEVAGNA Registered Office in via Orvieto 13 – 06039 Trevi (PG), Administrative Office in via Salvo d'acquisto 6 – 06031 Bevagna (PG) is the Organizer of the 4th Edition of the Queen Trophy, a *Adventouring Tourism* Event registered in the FMI National Calendar on September 11-12-13, 2020.

Art. 2

The Event, which is nationwide and non-competitive – in compliance with the *ADVENTOURING TOURISM* Regulations –, is characterized by a taste for adventure. It is a Touristic-Cultural-Gastronomic Event that offers participants the opportunity of discovering places, villages, and people uncontaminated by mass tourism, but are the keepers of our people's traditions. The itinerary develops on roads open to public traffic, approximately 30% of which are asphalted roads and 70% back and dirt roads; it is divided into three legs for a total of about 620km. All participants are required to strictly comply with the Highway Code.

The Organizer is to supply participants with track directions - max 9.999 points GPS track or other format at the request of participants -, general information on transit points, mileage, eventual route cuts, refueling, provisions, etc. in writing. The supplied itineraries have been communicated and authorized by the competent authorities for the Territory, participants are to follow these indications in order not to incur any penalties.

The given mileage may be subject to variations (increasing or decreasing) due to unforeseen causes or forced deviations.

Art. 3

Motorcycles allowed: in compliance with the FMI Regulations on 2021 *Adventouring Tourism* Events all motorcycles complying with the Highway Code are allowed to participate.

Art. 4

Technical Dispositions: It is highly recommended:

- To use approved dot knobby tires,
- To wear Enduro type clothing with technical boots, limb and chest protectors, and an approved helmet,
- To carry – on board of your motorcycle – spare air chambers (we recommend the normal type ones), the fundamental spare parts, such as brake clutch levers, and a series of tools suitable for the specific vehicle.

Failure to comply with these provisions may result in being excluded from the event.

Art. 5

Were a rider to change the registered bike, he is required to notify the Motoclub Pepe BEVAGNA no later than September, 3. Failure to comply this provision results in participants exclusion from the event with no right to any refund nor compensation.

Art.6

Anyone in possession of a valid motorcycle driving license and of an FMI (the sponsor of the event) membership card are allowed to participate to the event, irrespectively of their citizenship or nationality. An FMI membership card may be requested from any of the Moto Clubs in Italy or directly from the Pepe Bevagna Moto Club, see info on the registration form.

Art.7

Checking on registrations, papers, and motorcycles, as well as gadgets and relevant documentation delivery will be carried out on:

- Friday September 10, 2021 from 7.00 to 11.30 in Bevagna (PG) at the Mercato Coperto in Piazza Silvestri.
- For those taking part in the 2-days event, operations will be carried out on Friday September 10 from 16.00 to 18.30.
- The Briefing on the first leg will be held Friday September 10, 2021 at 12.20 in BEVAGNA.
- The Briefing on the second leg will be held Friday September 10, 2021 at 21.30 in Norcia.
- The Briefing on the third leg will be held Saturday September 11, 2021 at 21.30 in Cittaducale

Art. 8

Departure:

- Friday September 10, 2021 from Piazzale Masci Minolfo in Bevagna at 13.00. Participants are requested to arrive at the meeting place at 12.30 for baggage delivery and reordering. Pilots will leave in groups of 3/5 riders every 60 seconds, according to the assigned progressive numbers, due to management, assistance, and safety reasons.
- Saturday September 11, from Piazza S. Benedetto in Norcia at 8.00, meeting at 7.30 for baggage delivery.
- Sunday September 12, from Piazza del Popolo in Cittaducale (RI) at 5.30, meeting at 5.00.

ANY WITHDRAWING participant is under the OBLIGATION to notify the **Queen Trophy emergency** number in the Departure area before 12.30, 7.30, 5.00, respectively.

The Organization reserves the right to suspend, cancel or modify departure in case of force majeure.

Art. 9

All participants will be given a control table where all passages will be ticked during the event. Check points will be set along the entire track to verify the transit of riders and provide information and help. ALL participants are required to stop and have their control table stamped. We advise to consult the roadmap and overall schedule to work out the right cruising speed.

Riders are requested to proceed with their group so as to help each other in case of need.

The expected average speed has been calculated for a fun and safe ride, offering you time to take pictures and stop and relax if you so wish.

In case of inclement weather, running speed should be adjusted according to road practicability. We RECOMMEND to follow WET tracks.

ALL participants ARE TO communicate their eventual WITHDRAWAL FROM THE EVENT as soon as possible to the **Queen Trophy emergency** number.

Art. 10

GPS tracks will be supplied on September 10 during registration checking, while on September 11 you will be notified of the code to access the Whip Live Control System. Whip Live Control System is pivotal for your own safety since it would greatly speed rescue operations, hence you are requested to download this app on your smart-phone.

Riders are to show evidence that the track legs have been loaded on their GPS systems prior to departure.

Art. 11

A team of doctors and specialized personnel will be riding or driving (Jeep cars) behind the participants to ensure first aid non-specialist medical and mechanical assistance.

Please do help us help you by having on board all necessary items for punctures, lever replacement, etc.

In case of more complex mechanical failures, a rescue vehicle will be called, transportation fees are at the rider's account.

Art. 12

The Organization will offer baggage service upon request. You will be given a card where to write your name and address to apply to your luggage. The Organization shall not be held responsible for the contents of the baggage nor for its loss in case the identification card is not properly secured.

Service available during checking operations at a daily cost of €7.50

Art. 13

The registration fee is indicated in "Participation Options" and includes all items therein described, including the FMI event insurance, overnight accommodation, petrol, and mechanical first aid assistance.

Mandatory FMI membership fee, overnight accommodation, petrol, vehicle rescue, and anything else NOT expressly included, included is to be considered EXCLUDED.

Art. 14

Maximum number of participants: 140. The Organization reserves the right to exceed this limit at its sole discretion.

Art. 15

In case of a withdrawal due to a documented impediment, the participant shall be entitled to a refund equal to 50% of the duly paid fee, SUBJECT to sending a written notice via registered mail or PEC before August 26, 2021 to the following address:

No refund shall be claimable after any notice received after August 26, 2021.

Any eventual refund shall be paid within 30 days from the end of the event.

Art. 16

In case the event is cancelled due to force majeure, no registration fee shall be reimbursed.

Art. 16 Bis

COVID 19 is not to be intended as a "force majeure cause". Eventual cancellations due to COVID 19, the paid registration fee amount may be used towards registering for the 2022 event.

Art. 17

Failure to comply with the hereinafter regulations will result in the Immediate Disqualification of the Rider:

- Queen Trophy Regulations.
- Highway Code.
- Non-compliant clothing, non-knobby tires, lack of spare parts, etc. as indicated in Art. 4.
- Skipping the meeting, unless promptly notified and due to serious impediment.
- Reckless driving which could endanger other riders and/or third parties.

Art. 18

Any dispute arising out of or in connection with the participation to this Queen Trophy, any dispute arising out of or in connection with these Regulations, including, but not limited to any issue regarding their enforceability, and interpretation shall be exclusively referred to and finally resolved by the Event Resolution Commission (CDE).

The Organization reserves the right to modify these Regulations by giving notice – by means of numbered and dated newsletters, and/or press releases, and/or Web – as it may deem appropriate. Such amendments shall be deemed as an integral part of these Regulations.

Art. 19

Refusal of Registration: The Organization reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to refuse/withdraw registration to those participants who are deemed unsuitable/incompatible to participate in the Queen Trophy 2021.

Art. 20

Image Rights: by registering to the Queen Trophy, each participant TACITALLY AUTHORIZES the Moto Club Pepe Bevagna to the publication and dissemination of his/her image both in picture and video or any other format. Furthermore, he gives mandate and authorization to professionals of the sector to carry out video/photographic sessions.

Art.21

By registering to the Event, Riders implicitly agree they have read and understood these Regulations - which discipline the event – in their entirety and undertake to comply with them. Furthermore, Riders agree to release the Organizing Committee, the Sponsoring Bodies and any other Physical Entity, with no exception, from any and all liability arising from damage to people or property as a result of their participation in this event. The travel to and from their home place to the meeting places. By registering to the event, participants waive their rights to refer to the Court of Law or any other such Body. These Regulations may be subject to updates which will be eventually communicated during preliminary operations.

IN THE EVENT OF A DISPUTE, THE ITALIAN VERSION SHALL PREVAIL
